1. Program Name: Doctoral Educational Program «8D03115 – International Relations»
(*training direction «8D031 – Social Sciences»*).

2. Duration: 3 years

3. Total credits (ECTS): 184

4. Program description:

The program aims to train highly qualified specialists capable of conducting independent scientific research in the field of international relations, based on systematic and in-depth use of methods of applied analysis and research.

The program covers modern international theories and concepts, key areas of policy and security and foreign political priorities and national interests of Kazakhstan.

The program is based upon the strategic documents, determining the priorities of the state's foreign policy – the 2025 Strategic Development Plan of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the Concept of Foreign Policy of the Republic of Kazakhstan for 2020-2030.

5. Program Purpose and Objectives:

Purpose: To train advance experts and researchers in the field of international relations.

Program Objectives:

-develop research competencies for conducting research focused on solving actual foreign policy of Kazakhstan so that the results of the carried research can be introduced in state bodies.

- to provide in-depth and detailed awareness on current international processes and Kazakhstan's role and place in regional and international politics.

- instruction in three languages: Kazakh, Russian and English.

Formation / development of competencies:
