- **1. Name of the program:** Master's Program «7M04122 Regional Development» (direction of training «7M041-Business and Management»).
 - 2. Study period: 1 year
 - 3. Total credits (ECTS): 64
 - 4. Description of the program:

The Master's Program «Regional Development» was developed taking into account the tasks assigned to the state apparatus of the country and is aimed at developing the competencies of civil servants to ensure the sustainable balanced developments of the regions μ of Kazakhstan and improve the efficiency of local public administration.

To get a master's degree, you need to master 64 credita's and defend your master's project. From the 39 credits of the theoretical block, the master's student is given the opportunity to choose 10 credits from the catalog of elective disciplines, to choose courses in accordance with the professional specialization and individual learning path.

5. The goal and objectives of the program:

Aim: to train civil servants involved in regional development issues, who are able to offer sound solutions for effective management of socio-economic processes in the region, apply modern methods and technologies for managing regional projects, territorial development programs, etc.

Objectives of the program:

- to teach regional planning, forecasting, and management technologies for socio-economic processes;
- to develop competencies and provide students with technologies for developing behavioraloŭ strategies for making informed decisions in the field of regional sustainable development management.

6. Benefits of the program:

- competence-based approach to teaching, practice-and result-oriented learning through solving specific situations using interactive teaching methods;
- an interdisciplinary approach, that provides an opportunity to gain knowledge and skills in related fields;

- possibility of practical training and internships in government bodies of Kazakhstan and abroad:

 - trilingual education: Kazakh, Russian, and English;

- development of professional and expert networking, interaction with government officials from various ministries and departments, peer learning.
