1. Name of the program: Master's Degree Program «7M04106 – Economics» (training direction «7M041 – Business and Management»).

2. Term of study: 1,5 year

3. Total Credits (ECTS): 90

4. Program description:

The program is developed taking into account the best international practices and is aimed at training civil servants with modern economic thinking, competencies in the field of economics, able to think critically and make effective management decisions.

5. Aims and objectives of the program:

Purpose: training of civil servants with modern economic thinking, possessing tools of economic analysis for the development of the economy of the industry, region, country.

Objectives of the program:

- development of skills to apply methods of collecting and processing information for economic analysis and management decision-making;
- formation of skills to analyze and model economic processes at the level of the country, industry, region;
- formation of skills to assess the effectiveness of the country's economic policy;
- formation of skills to develop and implement methods of analytical work to improve the competitiveness of the country's economy.

6. Benefits of the program:
